

How to use this guide

Arts in Junior Cycle encourages active engagement when using short films in the classroom. The questions and activities below are a small sample of ways that this film featuring Annemarie Reinhold could be incorporated into the lessons. Teachers will need to consider the unique context and both age and stage of their students when planning how best to use the film and adapt this resource accordingly.



Key Skills focus: Being Creative | Communicating | Managing Information & Thinking

Before Viewing

Consider prior knowledge in anticipation of viewing

- Have you ever thought you were going to hate something but ended up loving it once you tried it?
- When working on a project, how do you gather your thoughts and ideas?
- Are you wearing any jewellery? Where do you think the idea came from for that piece and how do you think it was made?

While Viewing

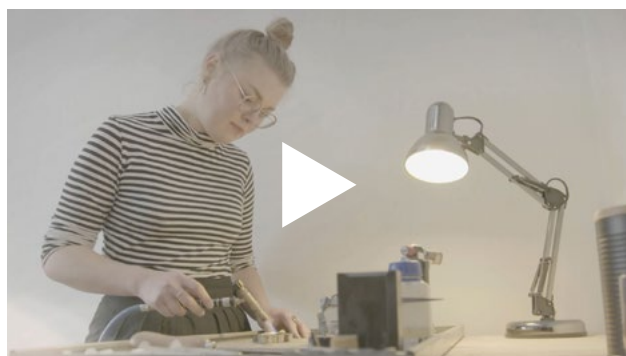
Support active viewing. On second and subsequent viewing, pausing may be used for specific focus

- Annemarie mentions growing up in the countryside and going off on her own to discover bits of nature. Have you had a similar experience? Does nature inspire your design and craft?
- During her design process Annemarie does a lot of sketching and modelling before progressing to her final piece. What do you think are the advantages of sketching and modelling?
- Annemarie speaks about gaining confidence as she learned from one of her favourite artists, and realising she could do it. How do you gain confidence in your craft?

After Viewing

Follow up on key ideas and synthesize information learned

- Consider how you approach the design process. How do you research? What does your process look like?
- Has your understanding of a jewellery designer / metal sculptor changed as a result of seeing Annemarie at work? How so?
- Annemarie speaks about the importance of exploring different things and seeing how it makes you feel. What new things could you explore?
